NOTICE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION OPT OUT

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) provides that a student's education records are generally confidential. The records won't be released to a third party without a parent's or college student's consent. There are some exceptions, however.

The law allows your school to release publicly "directory information" about a student without consent. Directory information contains personal and identifiable information. Once this information is disclosed, anyone can use the information as they please. Marketers, profilers, and identity thieves value student information and can use it for years.

You can protect your student's personal information by opting-out of disclosure. Just complete and sign the Form below. Return the form to your school within the first 30 days of school.
